MARINE CIRCULAR 12/2009

TO Ship Owners, Ship Managers, Charterers, Ship Master and the Shipping Community

SUBJECT International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1992

PURPOSE

This Circular is to notify the shipping community on procedure to apply for Civil Liability Convention Certificate (CLCC).

APPLICATION

This Circular is applicable for ships carrying more than 2,000 tons of oil in bulk as cargo.

CONTENT

The CLC was adopted to ensure that adequate compensation is available to persons who suffer oil pollution damage resulting from maritime casualties involving oil-carrying ships. The CLC places the liability for such damage on the owner of the ship from which the polluting oil escaped or was discharged.

All seagoing ships carrying more than 2,000 tons of oil in bulk as cargo are required to carry onboard a valid CLCC issued by Kiribati Ship Registry.

To apply for CLCC, owners/managers should submit the following via email to <u>ops@kiribaship.com</u> or on-line via KRIS (Kiribati Registration for International Ships) portal:
